Highlights of the Event	The purpose of the Field Visit was to provide the students a chance to apply concepts of Psychology in a practical setting. Missionaries of Charity Home for the Sick and Dying Destitute in Venkatala Village, Yelahanka was started in 1970. The nuns selflessly look after people who are aged, disabled and/or psychiatric patients. The inmates are abandoned by their family and are destitute. The NGO houses 78 inmates. They receive: *Assistance with Day-to-day living *Healthcare services *Safety *Regular meals *Specialised healthcare *Housekeeping services *Social engagement The nuns look after babies abandoned in railway stations, bus stands and dust bins. They raise the babies and provide education so that they can become independent. The inmates who interacted with us welcomed us warmly. They are so full of life and faith even though they have been abandoned. The field visit helped the students to understand the psychological problems faced by the inmates and the care given to them. They learnt about Animal Assisted Therapy. In this kind of psychotherapy, the patients experience a change in their behaviour because of animals. Animals can help to reduce symptoms of anxiety, fear and worry. It also helps in bringing about a healthy blood pressure and hormone levels. It helps in social, emotional and cognitive functioning. It helps in reducing the symptoms of the inmates suffering from mental disorders. A small donation was made by collecting money from the facuity and students of Department of Arts. As part of community social service, we would like to contribute financially from the college as a whole in the future



In this program, the committee members and some selected students planned two days in a week to teach the children English, Science and Mathematics subjects.


Compared to the previous year, this year pass percentage of pupils was improved. The school Head Master and village panchayat PDO had bestowed on us a Letter of Appreciation.
