

The contest will comprise of two sessions, namely the **Prepared Speech** Session and the **Impromptu Speech** Session.

Participation in both sessions is mandatory for all contestants. There will be 3 rounds of the contest: Preliminary round, Semi-final round and Final round.

Prepared Speech

- Contestants are free to speak on any topic of their choice. However, speech content which discriminates a particular section of a community or is politically motivated may result in a disqualification or reduction of points.
- Contestants must prepare their own speeches and each must be substantially original. Any quote, paraphrased or referenced content must be so identified during the speech presentation.
- Contestants are allowed to present the same speech content for all rounds.

Impromptu Speech

- Speech must be substantially original. Any quote, paraphrased or referenced content must be so identified during the speech presentation.
- In the preliminary round only, a 5-minute preparation time will be allocated from the moment the topic is revealed to the contestant.
- In the semi-final and final rounds, no preparation time will be given. Once the contestant enters the hall, the name of the contestant and the topic will be announced by the contest chair. Following that, the contestant must immediately walk to the speaking area and start the speech.

The contest will be held in any medium (English/Kannada/Hindi/Telugu/Tamil).

- 10 contestants (subject to change depending on the number of contestants at the preliminary round) will be selected from the preliminary round to compete at the semi-final round. In addition, 2 reserves will also be selected.
- ➢ 6 contestants will be selected from the semi-final round to compete at the final round. In addition, 2 reserves will also be selected.
- > Best Speaker, First Runner-up, Second Runner-up will be selected in the final round.

Speech Timings

In the preliminary round,

Speech should be between 3 to 4 minutes. Speaker will be disqualified if the speech exceeds 4 minutes 30 seconds.

In the semi-final and final rounds,

Speech should be between 5 to 6 minutes. Speaker will be disqualified if the speech exceeds 6 minutes 30 seconds.

In the preliminary round,

A green card will be displayed at 3 minutes and remain displayed for 1 minute.

A yellow card will be displayed at 4 minutes and remain displayed for 1 minute.

A red card will be displayed at 4:30 minutes and will remain displayed until the conclusion of the speech.

In the semi-final and final rounds,

A green card will be displayed at 5 minutes and remain displayed for 1 minute.

A yellow card will be displayed at 6 minutes and remain displayed for 1 minute.

A red card will be displayed at 6:30 minutes and will remain displayed until the conclusion of the speech.

Speeches will be judged on the basis of the following criteria.

Speech Content (50%)

Speech Development - Structure, organization and support material Effectiveness - Achievement of purpose, interest and reception Speech value - Ideas, logic and originality of thoughts

Speech Delivery (30%)

Physical – Appearance, body language and speaking area Manner - Directness, assurance and enthusiasm Voice - Flexibility and volume

Language (20%)

Appropriateness - To speech purpose and to audience Correctness - Grammar, pronunciation and word selection


This principles says that the directing function should create self-confidence amongst the subordinate and motivate them so that they give their best to the organisation.


