Report


The Alumni Association of the college organized a "Photography workshop" on 23/07/2022 from 10:30 am to 1:00pm. The expert invited for the session was the aluminus of the college Mr. Marwin D'Souza passed out in 2011 with BBM. The speaker elaborated on the various technical points of photography including the parts of camera practically demonstrating using the camera, different types of lenses used to focus the light reflected or emitted from the objects into a real image inside the camera. He threw light on the finer aspects of the techniques involved in image focusing when a photograph is taken.

Mr. Marwim explained in detail about the differences between the conventional manual photography and digital system of photography. The speaker mentioned that in digital system with an electronic image sensor, electrical charges are produced at each pixel, which is electronically processed and stored in a image file for subsequent image.

Learning Outcome of the session: All the students attended the session got fine aspects of photography and also learnt about the image focusing, filtering of light and choosing the appropriate lens for a particular purpose. Overall the session was very much interesting and informative. Students had very good and fruit full interaction with the speaker.











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Event - Seminar on Entrepreneurship, Import and Export

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The Alumni Association has organized seminar on "Entrepreneurship, Import and Export". The guest speaker for the day was the aluminus of the college Mr. Vikram Ullal, passed out in 2007 with BBM, on 21-07-2022 from 1:30pm to 3.00 pm.

Mr. Vikram, an entrepreneur by himself, initially made students understand about import and export with examples. He discussed in detail about the role of an entrepreneur in creating opportunities and produce goods and services and help establish strong industrial base. He also mentioned that it will help reducing imports and at the same time promote local products and brands globally, thus increasing exports.

He illustrated that together import and export make up a country's balance of trade, which can impact an overall economic health of the country. Student participants keenly involved themselves in the session and had an excellent interaction with the speaker.

Learning Outcome: Students could learn and appreciate that how in a healthy economy of a country, both imports and exports see continual growth and therefore, represent a sustainable and strong economy in a country.
